New Procedure for General Play Score Submission - UPDATED/REVISED

(Effective 1 May 2026)

Until now, active federation members who had registered and activated their account on MyCGF portal were able to submit General Play Score (Previously called EDS) for a score played on any course which has been slope-rated by the CGF in Cyprus. This was in accordance with the Rules of Handicapping 2024 as published on the CGF website. Oversight of this process was limited to random checks by the CGF, who then flagged the player's home club of any suspicious activity.

Following a review of this process, and in alignment with the policies adopted by other European federations, the HR&CRC will be introducing a revised system for submitting a General Play Score. The updated procedure streamlines both registration and score entry while incorporating essential safeguards to ensure proper validation. The new process will become effective on 1 May 2026.

New Submission Process

Players should pre-register their intended General Play Score via their MyCGF account before play. This action generates a timestamp recording their intention to submit a scorecard. After completion of play, players must return to MyCGF portal to enter their scores hole by hole. All scores should be submitted by 2400 that same evening.

Submitted scores are transmitted to the Datagolf server and HI will be adjusted accordingly.

Oversight

A Player's home club Competition Secretary or Handicap Secretary will be responsible to ensure ALL General Play Scores are reviewed. If a card raises concerns, the Competition Secretary will inform the Player and the matter will be referred to the Club's Competition and/or Handicap Committee as appropriate.

Competition Secretaries are expected to review submitted scores regularly and without undue delay (recommended minimum: three times per week, one of those days should be before any competition is played).

All players should note that EVERY General Play Score is subject to club review.

Scores Played Outside Cyprus

Rounds played on officially rated courses abroad must continue to be submitted directly to the player's home club Handicap Administrator. Acceptance of such scores remains at the discretion of the club.

Summary

In summary, the updated MyCGF portal enhances player responsibility in score submission while reinforcing the critical role of the Competition Secretary in the validation process. Clear communication and consistent oversight will be key to ensuring a smooth transition and safeguarding the integrity of Handicap Indexes on the island.

It is essential that the Clubs communicate these changes clearly to all members.
